- Incoming freshmen to Southern Arkansas University, (SAU) Magnolia, AR seeking four-year Agriculture degree
- 2.5 or better GPA
- 19 or better ACT Score

Students must complete application and attach the following items:

- ◆ Cover letter from Student stating:
 - ◆ How this scholarship will be beneficial to you
 - ◆ Data sheet listing school/community activities, awards, honors, etc.
- ◆ Two letters of recommendation – one must be from a school official
- ◆ Transcript with test scores

Scholarship covers \$2000 annually for four years as long as student continues to meet eligibility requirements of:

- Continue in Agriculture degree
- Continue degree with SAU Magnolia, AR
- Carry a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester
- Maintain GPA of 2.5 or better (if cumulative GPA falls below 2.5 at the end of a semester, there will be a probation period of one semester to bring GPA up to retain scholarship)

To continue to receive the scholarship, send original transcript following the spring semester to Great Lakes at the address listed below. The payment will be made prior to the fall semester of each year and will be made directly to the SAU Foundation for the recipient.
